### A Contract to Obey the Ten A Closer Walk Commandments

1. Go to give compliments and encouraging words to other people in our group. No complaining about anything - Numbers 11:1.
2. Go with a teachable attitude everyday.
3. Go to serve God by cleaning up camp when it's your turn. You are required to participate in camp clean up i.e., garbage duty, etc.
